Cass Business School Welcomes TPRE delegation

A delegation of 26 representatives from the Tianjin Property Rights Exchange and a number of major state-owned and privately-held enterprises in China recently visited the UK to attend a training programme, at Cass Business school, to expand their knowledge of the global money and capital markets.

The Tianjin Property Rights Exchange operates under the State-owned Assets Supervision and Administration Commission (SASAC) which is responsible for overseeing the development and regulation of state-owned enterprises in Tianjin. PanCathay is the UK representative of TPRE and organised this programme with CASS to help delegates gain a better understanding of the London capital market and financial services industry.



During the two day programme, the delegates were given lectures on subjects including the London money and capital markets, derivatives and alternate investments and mergers and acquisitions. The group also visited the City of London Marketing Suite and the London Stock Exchange and were treated by Royal Bank of Scotland to a formal dinner in the Coutts private dining room.

Gao Luan, Director of the Tianjin Property Rights Exchange, said: "Tianjin is developing very quickly and we need more knowledge of international capital markets. This programme has helped us to develop our knowledge in these areas." Madeleine Sturrock, Managing Director of PanCathay Consulting, coordinated the programme and said: "The Tianjin municipality is the third largest and most important city in China. It

is receiving significant development support from the Chinese Government and, as it grows, it is important that those people overseeing development and regulation have specialised knowledge of the global finance market.

"Cass Business School was selected for this programme because of the School's location and relationship with the City of London. The delegates have really enjoyed being able to get a feel for the working of the City."
